



How to draw a plan for quoting purposes

What you will need:

Paper, pen, tape measure & camera

1. Draw the benchtop shape of your kitchen layout (refer to samples below as a guide) N.B: Scale drawing not required
2. Using the symbols as shown in the legend below, mark the appropriate edge finishes, walls etc
3. Indicate location of sink and cooktop however measurements are not required for quoting purposes
4. Be sure to include any additions or changes you are looking to make such as removal of walls, raised breakfast benches or the addition of waterfall ends. *Your photos will help us visualise your plans*
5. Take 2-3 photos of your existing kitchen from various angles and include them with your sketch. This helps us identify if there is anything out of the ordinary
6. Email your sketch (spare graph paper provided below) and photos to info@superiorbenchtops.com.au along with your contact details and any other relevant information

LEGEND:

Red lines denote the dimension required

X = square edge/end

--- = joint

|| – rolled edge

WF = waterfall end

If no edge finish indicated, it will be supplied as a raw edge

If your benchtop runs into a recessed window sill, just provide the deepest dimension for the benchtop and advise on the drawing that this is the situation
